Any club which does not send score cards by that date will not have their score counted for the National Playing Fields Shield or MacRobert Thistle Cup. The National Playing Fields Shield for each Area will be presented to the club with the two winning fours that have the highest total score. The MacRobert Thistle Cup will be presented to the Fife club with the highest overall score. In the event of a tie, Rule 4 of the Gilmour Trophy will apply. All those trophies will be presented to the respective winners at the **Fife Bowling Association Finals at Auchtermuchty B.C. on Saturday 2nd July 2011**.
